The Bay County Tourist Development Council (TDC) officially announce the start of the latest beach renourishment project. The project which is conducted through the Army Corp of Engineers, scheduled to begin in September 2021 and last until



Spring 2022. The project is slated to included areas between St. Andrews State Park and Ocean Towers, as well as the City Pier and Pinnacle Port. Majestic Beach Resort is within the project area.
